

# Foundation Apprenticeship in Warehousing and Storage

#### Overview

This qualification is suitable for individuals who are involved in warehousing and storage as their primary work activity and wish to receive recognition for their experience or, if new to a career in warehousing and storage, wish to take the next steps towards professional qualifications. The Apprenticeship consists of qualifications that are included in the Qualifications and Credit Framework (QCF) and provides a flexible approach to learning through the selection of units and credits. The qualifications can be achieved through a mixture of portfolio building, observation, assessment and knowledge and understanding questioning.

### The qualifications within the Apprenticeship include:

- > Level 2 NVQ Certificate in Warehousing and Storage
- > Essential Skills Level 1 in Communication
- > Essential Skills Level 1 in Application of Number

#### Level 2 NVQ Certificate in Warehousing and Storage

This certificate is made up of units at levels 2 and 3 where learners can demonstrate their knowledge, skills and experience in Warehousing and Storage. Each unit has a credit value and in order to complete the certificate, learners are required to achieve a minimum of 26 credits. These are to be achieved from the 2 Mandatory units, 2 units from Option Group 1, 1 unit from Option Groups 2, 3 and 4 plus units from Option Group 5 to the value of 6 credits.


The following table will outline the units and their credit value available for selection:
